A point of clarification that I wish to post on the CEAA Prosperity website if I may.

In a requested attempt to be brief during my WL presentation on April 28, I didn't provide the steelhead excel spreadsheet and related discussion that details estimated spawners in the Chilcotin system. My Powerpoint slide # 13 states "

From a high of 3149 in 1985 to the 2009 estimate of 72 in 2009. Not a pretty picture at all".

The point to make is that the 1985 number is an annual estimate and the 2009 number is an individual daily count. However my point remains the same that in reviewing the spreadsheet one can see that the steelhead population in the Chilcotin River is much lower than the historical number of spawners.
