Re: Invitation to participate in the public comment period on the Environmental Impact Statement Addendum for the Marathon Palladium Project

Dear John Clarke,

The Joint Review Panel (the Panel) for the proposed Marathon Palladium Project (the Project) has announced the start of the public comment period on the Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) Addendum submitted by Generation PGM Inc. The EIS Addendum is available on the Canadian Impact Assessment Registry document [#727](#).

The EIS Addendum was submitted in two parts. On January 7, 2021, the Panel received Volume 1 of the EIS Addendum, which includes chapters 1-4. The remaining chapters of the EIS Addendum were submitted to the Panel on April 16, 2021 as Volume 2. Now that the complete EIS Addendum is available, the Panel has initiated a 70-day public comment period ending on **June 27, 2021**.

The Panel requests the participation of Natural Resources Canada in the review of the EIS Addendum to ensure that sufficient information is available before proceeding to the public hearing. In particular, the Panel requests that Natural Resources Canada review the technical merit of the information contained in the EIS Addendum, and supporting documents, as measured against the EIS Guidelines and related to Natural Resources Canada's mandate and expertise.

If Natural Resources Canada is of the view that there is sufficient information to proceed to a public hearing, please advise the Panel. Otherwise, Natural Resources Canada is requested to identify what information is being requested using the format outlined in Appendix A. The Panel will determine if the EIS Addendum is sufficient to proceed to the public hearing based on its own review of the information and taking into consideration any comments that are received.
