Generation PGM Inc would like to provide the following response to CIAR #842 dated June 25, 2021.

Environment and Climate Change Canada (ECCC) is thanked for their clarification. Previous recommendations from Environment and Climate Change Canada (ECCC) regarding the appropriate geographic scale for analyses of potential Project impacts on woodland caribou and their habitat were incorporated in the updated impact analysis, along with previous and current provincial direction. Generation PGM Inc (GenPGM), the past proponent and Northern Bioscience have consulting with the Ontario MNR and MECP as the leading authority and data holder and received data files from both ministries for caribou in the Coastal Range and the analysis of impacts did consider potential impacts on the Discontinuous Distribution in Volume 2 of the Marathon Palladium Project Environmental Impact Statement Addendum (Section 6.2.8 and Appendix D9).
