For the record, the Town of Marathon issues the following response to the Undertaking 31 extension request:

1. The Town supports the request to the Panel for a 4-week extension to the deadline for filing GenPGM's response to Undertaking 31 (Agreed BN-GenPGM Request) with a due for filing date of May 12, 2022. The Town and BN are the two communities most directly impacted by this project, so we support this due diligence between the two parties.
2. The Town does not support the deference of closing remarks past the planned April 13 date and believes that an entire process delay is not necessary at this point in time. Delaying closing remarks will provide no substantive or probative value to the hearing process at this juncture.
