- 1. I am a member of the Whitefish Lake First Nation #128 (the "Nation") and I am a hunter, fisherman, gatherer and trapper within the Nation's traditional territory and as such I have personal knowledge of the matters deposed to in this Affidavit, except where stated to be based on information and belief and where so stated I verily believe the same to be true.
- 2. Now produced and shown to me and marked as **Exhibit "A"** to this my Affidavit is a true copy of a map depicting a portion of the Nation's traditional territory, the proposed Coal Valley Resources Inc.'s. ("**Coal Valley**") Robb Trend Project and the areas where I have and continue to hunt, fish, trap and gather. Attached to this my Affidavit and marked as **Exhibit "B"** is a true copy of a map depicting a portion of the Nation's traditional territory and the areas where I have and continue to hunt, fish, trap and gather.
- I hunt, fish, trap and gather and have hunted, fished, trapped and gathered on unoccupied Crown lands and lands to which I have or previously had a right of access within the Nation's traditional territory. I have hunted in the marked areas, as shown in **Exhibit** "A" and **Exhibit** "B" as a child and into my adulthood.
- 4. In these areas I have hunted the following animals, including, but not limited to:
  - a. Birds, which include, but not limited to grouse, ducks, geese;
  - b. Moose;
  - c. Elk;
  - d. White Tail Deer;
  - e. Mule Deer;
  - f. Bighorn; and
  - g. Rabbits.

5.	In the marked area, I have fished the following, including but not limited to:		
	a.	Whitefish;

	d.	Jackfish (Northern Pike); and

	e.	Saskatoon Berries;

	g.	Huckleberries;

	i.	Chokecherries; and	
	j.	Traditional medicines, which include, but not limited to, muskeg tea/Labrador tea, muskeg, mountain ash, sweetgrass, sage, and roots and bark.	
7.	In the marked area, I have trapped the following, including but not limited to:		
	a.	Rabbits.	
8.	As a hunter, fisherman, gatherer and trapper, I am concerned that the activities conducted by Coal Valley for the proposed coal project will further impact the wildlife populations in the area. The activities of Coal Valley and the proposed coal project will also occupy lands to which I have previously had a right of access and will further restrict the area in		


which I can exercise my Treaty rights to hunt, fish, gather and trap.


