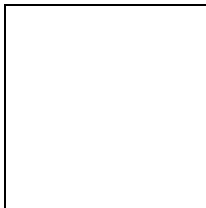

We wanted to make sure you received a copy of their comments.

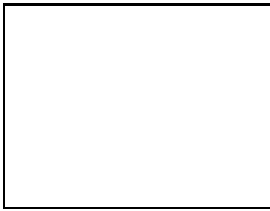
This commenting campaign is organized by [Voters Taking Action on Climate Change](#).
