Project Description:

Pretium Resources Inc. is currently operating a gold-silver underground mine located approximately 65 kilometres north of Stewart, British Columbia. The project will produce approximately 16 million tonnes of mineralized material at a rate of up to 2,700 tonnes per day over a minimum 22-year mine life.
