Re: Termination of the Federal Environmental Assessment of the Coal Mountain Phase 2 Project

Thank you for your letter dated August 4, 2022, in which you requested the Impact Assessment Agency of Canada (the Agency) terminate the federal environmental assessment of the Coal Mountain Phase 2 Project (the Project).

Based on the information provided in your letter, the Agency has accepted your request on behalf of Teck Coal Limited, and has terminated the environmental assessment pursuant to Section 62 of the *Canadian Environmental Assessment Act, 2012* (CEAA 2012).

The Notice of Termination has been posted on the *Canadian Impact Assessment Registry* internet site (Reference Number: 80086).

IMPORTANT NOTE: Termination of the environmental assessment, pursuant to Section 62 of CEAA 2012, does not limit the future application of the *Impact Assessment Act* (IAA) to the Project. Should this or a similar project be proposed at a future date, an impact assessment under the IAA may be required. If the

proposed project were defined in the *Physical Activities Regulations* under the IAA, then the proponent would be required to submit an Initial Project Description to the Agency, in accordance with Section 10 of the IAA.
