Concerning the proposed CN Logistic Hub for Milton, I am in favour of the project going ahead.

I believe the addition of the proposed Hub will be good for business and good for the community. It will make it easier for businesses that receive or ship via CN and be an alternative for those who ship via road. Also, it will reduce the transport traffic currently on the road in this area since the road transit will only be to/from the hub/destination and not entirely through the community for goods moving from the US to say Toronto. I have heard some comments from local authorities that the Hub will bring eight-hundred plus trucks a day. I think we already have that number but the Hub will enable the trucks to get off the road and onto the rails, thereby creating a significant benefit for other drivers. Perhaps, if the Hub is successful, it could delay the need for a second major highway to the Buffalo/Niagara border.

Overall, I think we should be encouraging this type of initiative.
