Mr. Northey,

Yesterday, on behalf of the Halton Municipalities you requested an extension to the 12pm deadline for the filing of written closing remarks due to significant technical difficulties with the submission. The Review Panel agreed to grant Halton Municipalities' an extension and requested that a draft of the written closing remarks be submitted by 2pm, and the final document, with an errata document to identify the changes, be provided by 5pm (CEAR #971).

Halton Municipalities complied with the Review Panel's request and filed the draft version and final version of the closing remarks document in accordance with the 2pm and 5pm timelines established by the Review Panel. Both the draft and final version of the document, along with the errata clarifying the changes, are posted on the Registry under document #973.

However, at 5pm when Halton Municipalities filed the final version of its written closing remarks it also filed a document entitled *BRIEF OF ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTS REFERRED TO IN THE CLOSING REMARKS OF THE HALTON MUNICIPALITIES – July 17, 2019*. This document was not included in the original submission at 2pm, and Halton Municipalities did not give an indication at that time that it intended to file an additional 1,190 pages.

As the Brief of Additional Documents was not filed at the 2pm draft deadline stage, in accordance with the direction of the Review Panel, it will not be accepted into the record and will not be posted to the public Registry.
