As a citizen of Calgary who was greatly affected by the 2013 Flood, our household strongly supports the Calgary River Communities in voicing concern regarding the Canadian Environmental Assessment Agency's (CEAA) possible engagement in the environmental review of the Springbank Project.

Some key points for consideration:

- The provincial EIA Terms of Reference will ensure a comprehensive environmental assessment.
- The Alberta Environment and Parks Ministry is fully equipped to review the EIA without federal involvement.
- As the Springbank Project does not meet any of the CEAA criteria as a designated project, a federal review is not mandated or required.
- A CEAA review will extend the timeframe and create potential for further delays for the Springbank Project, increasing risk to downstream communities including Calgary.
- The Springbank Project is in the best interests of Calgarians and Albertans and should proceed as quickly as possible.
