

## Notice of Determination

**September 06, 2021** – Global Affairs Canada issued its Notice of Determination and determined that the project is not likely to cause significant adverse environmental effects.

### Notice of Determination

**Ottawa – September 06, 2021** – Global Affairs Canada has determined that the proposed project Construction of 10 incinerators in 10 public health facilities (HF) in the departments of Mono and Atlantic is not likely to cause significant adverse environmental effects.

This determination was based on a consideration of the following factors:

- Community knowledge and implicated actors;
- Comments received from the public; and
- Technically and economically feasible mitigation measures.

Mitigation measures taken into account for this determination are:

- The reduction of natural and social risks,
- The reduction of risks and nuisances linked to the works,
- The conservation of natural resources and sensitive ecosystems

Global Affairs Canada is satisfied that that the carrying out of the project is not likely to cause significant adverse environmental effects.

Therefore, Global Affairs Canada may carry out the project, exercise any power, perform any duty or function, or provide financial assistance to enable the project to be carried out in whole or in part.
