Summary of the Project: In 2022, 27 million people are in need of humanitarian assistance in the DRC, a 7.4% increase from 2021. Currently, the DRC is home to the largest global food crisis, with an unprecedented 27 million people severely food insecure. In addition, it is home to the largest internally-displaced persons population in Africa with 5.5 million displaced people.
